

CSPH/MPH Core Course Equivalencies and Semesters Offered

Introduction: All MPH students are required to complete six core MPH courses. These courses may be taken at any of the three campuses. The table below shows the approved equivalent courses and the semesters they will be offered at each of the campuses. Students should be aware that they must take a minimum of 24 credit hours for their degree at their home campus. *(Exception: If a student completed a Colorado School of Public Health certificate program on a home campus different from their MPH home campus, they are required to complete 18 credit hours of coursework offered by their MPH home campus.)*

Important: (1) Students should register for only ONE of each of the six core courses – registering for an additional equivalent course is not permitted. If multiple equivalents of the same course are completed, the student will only be allowed to count one class towards completion of the program requirement. (2) Students who are planning to take more advanced courses in a particular department should generally take the version of the core course offered by that department.
